**SADO Three-day PASS**  
3 days unlimited bus rides  
Adults ¥3,000  
Children ¥1,500

**SADO Two-day PASS**  
2 days unlimited bus rides  
Adults ¥2,500  
Children ¥1,250

**SADO One-day PASS**  
1 day unlimited bus rides  
Adults ¥1,500  
Children ¥750



### Where to purchase:

You can purchase the bus day passes at the Niigata Kotsu Sado counter, every tourist information on Sado Island, at the Information Counter of the Sado Kisen Ferry Terminals in Niigata and Naoetsu, on the ferry, and with the bus driver. Furthermore, the bus day passes are available at some accommodations. Please direct any inquiries to Niigata Kotsu Sado for more details.

### Using the bus day passes, you get benefits at supporting facilities on meals, shopping, and entrance fees.

**How to use the bus day passes** ● You may use the bus day passes on all fixed route busses within the time frame indicated on the passes - for one, two, or three days. The ticket is not valid for sightseeing busses. ● The bus day passes are "scratch-off tickets". Please scratch off the year, month, and day of the date on which you board the bus the first time. When getting off the bus, just show it to the bus driver. ● **Do not scratch off more than one patch per category (year, month, day)** because the pass will be considered invalid then. ● The transportation fares to the closest Bus Day Pass sales counter cannot subsequently be covered with the then purchased Bus Day Pass. After the purchase, refunding is not possible.

## How to use the bus

\* On certain routes it is possible to get on and off the bus freely - even between bus stops. However, there are routes and sections where free boarding and alighting is not possible.

**1 Get on the bus at a bus stop**

On routes where you can get on and off the bus freely, please wait on the left side of the road at a safe spot and give the approaching bus a sign that you would like to board the bus by lifting your arm.

**2 Take a boarding ticket**

Get on the bus from the back door. Please take a boarding ticket from the box next to the door when getting on the bus. On the boarding ticket is a number.

**3 If you would like to get off at the next bus stop...**

... please push one of the "Stop-Buttons" when the bus approaches the bus stop you need to get off at.

**4 Confirm your fare**

The fare will be displayed on a screen at the front of the bus. Your fare is displayed under the same number as on your boarding ticket. You may exchange your money at the machine next to the bus driver. Change of larger bills such as ¥2,000, ¥5,000, and ¥10,000 is not possible.

**5 Pay your fare right before getting off the bus**

Fares, boarding tickets etc.  
Coin exchange  
Banknote exchange

Please wait until the bus has come to a complete halt to pay the transportation fare at the fare box.

Please note that the use of e-money such as Suica Card etc. is not possible.
